

Meeting: Marine Racing Club

Meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. Previous meeting minutes (May 2, 2011) were not read.

This meeting was called for the purpose of voting on whether Marine Racing Club would submit a bid to secure the North American Championship series for JH and JR at the 2012 Rochelle, IL race.

It will cost Marine Racing Club an extra \$150 per class (\$300 total) should we win the bid, which will be announced by APBA sometime in January, 2012. Discussion surfaced on why we are choosing to not include AXH and AXR in the bid; the reasoning is twofold. 1) It will cost an additional \$300. 2) No HOC points are awarded to the AXH and/or AXR winner in a NAC race.

With the 2012 Nationals again being hosted in the Midwest (Grass Lake, MI), it is thought by many MRC members in attendance at this meeting that JH and JR points-chasers from Michigan and Indiana will come to the NAC race at Rochelle to cover the \$300 outlay, and also bring with them their parent(s) and/or sibling(s) who also race, thus generating extra club income via additional entry fees collected for other classes.

Motion was made to call for a vote on whether MRC should submit a bid for NAC. Motion was seconded, and a vote was taken. A majority (but not unanimous) vote was logged FOR submitting a bid to host NAC for JH and JR at Rochelle in 2012. A recommendation was made to start lobbying for a bid, and to contact JH and JR parents in Michigan and Indiana to bring to their attention this potential NAC race.
